FAIRBORN COMPANY AWARDED BUSINESS INTELLIGENCE CONTRACT FOR EDUCATION COMMUNITY

FAIRBORN, OH, NOVEMBER 26, 2007: IntelliTech Systems, Inc. was awarded a contract to design and develop a Business Intelligence (BI) application for the Teacher Quality Partnership (TQP) based at the University of Cincinnati. This application will house data from on-going studies that are being performed at all 50 teacher preparation institutions in the state of Ohio. The TQP principal investigators will also have access to state-of-the-art analysis tools to perform research within the system.

The focus of the TQP project is to better understand the pathways and influences related to the teachers and to their ultimate influence on students' academic performance. The collected data will be analyzed within the system being developed, and reports detailing findings will be produced by the principal investigators of the research strands. The application is being developed using SAS, Futrix, and custom applications developed by the IntelliTech team.

IntelliTech has partnered with Pinnacle Solutions – a SAS consulting firm in Indianapolis. Dr. Robert Yinger, Research Director of TQP, oversees TQP's operations and is responsible for the

acquisition of the system and its ongoing use. Dr. Yinger stated, "This enterprise system will be the first of its kind in teacher education and will allow researchers unprecedented ability to study and model the teacher preparation and professional development systems in Ohio. We anticipate that the large-scale, longitudinal research made possible by this BI application will serve as a model for systemic educational research in other states in the future."
